RECOMMENDATION

Staff will provide a general update to the Board regarding a grant for fencing at the John H Furbee Aquatic Center.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

On April 21, 2015, the City Council adopted a resolution (Exhibit 1) authorizing acceptance of a \$10,000.00 grant from the Desert Healthcare District, to provide funding to build a wrought iron fence around the playground equipment located at the John H. Furbee Aquatic Center. The new section of fencing will separate the playground and outdoor gym area from the pool and splash pad area. The new fencing will also include a new access gate from outside of the pool area.

The City Council directed staff to apply for the Desert Healthcare District grant, which was subsequently approved and awarded. Staff is now working to secure bids for the fencing.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact. The Humana Foundation donated \$5,000 to the Desert Healthcare District and the Desert Healthcare District will match the funds, for a total of \$10,000.00
