TITLE: Second Reading and Adoption of an Ordinance Prohibiting Obstruction of Pedestrian Traffic and Carl May Center Parking Lot and Driveways Use Restrictions

RECOMMENDATION

Approve Second Reading, read by title only and adopt "An Ordinance of the City Council amending the Desert Hot Springs Municipal Code by 1) Adding Article VI "Obstruction of Pedestrian Traffic Prohibited," 2) Adding Article VII "Carl May Center Parking Lot, and Driveways Use Restrictions," and 3) Repealing Section 10.36.050 "Unreasonable Interference with Free Passage of Pedestrians" of Title 10 "Vehicles and Traffic."

BACKGROUND

The Ordinance (Exhibit 2) was introduced and approved for first reading by the City Council on January 17, 2017 as amended - to include the reference to "medians."

The Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its second reading.
