### RECOMMENDATION

Approve Second Reading, read by title only and adopt: "An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Desert Hot Springs, California, amending Section 2.04.060 ("Change of Election Day") of Article II ("Elections") of Chapter 2.04 ("City Council") of the Desert Hot Springs Municipal Code relating to moving the City's General Municipal Elections to the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each even-numbered year, which General Municipal Election shall commence November of 2018.

## **BACKGROUND**

The matter was presented to the City Council at a Study Session held on January 17, 2017.

On February 21, 2017, the City Council introduced and approved the Ordinance (Exhibit 2) for first reading.

The Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its second reading.
