RECOMMENDATION

That the Community and Cultural Affairs Commission discuss the development of a SoundXperience Summer Session Program with the first session taking place before student graduations begin. Additional sessions will be developed throughout the summer.

DISCUSSION

The Community and Cultural Affairs Commission should review hosting a community event that meets the needs of the youth in the community. The Special Events Sub-Committee can be responsible for this event.

The events could take place at the Skate Park located at the Tedesco Park free of charge to the youth in the community and would take place from 5:30-9:30 p.m. The first two events can take place the last two Fridays in May, which should give the Sub-Committee enough time to plan the event. The event would conclude at the end of the summer.

The expected budget will not exceed \$750. The Commission will provide the entertainment and food for the youth. Hot dogs would be free, but the youth can pay for chips and a soda, similar to how they operate in Palm Springs, unless the Commission decides differently. Any funds that remain can go back into the budget for other outside youth events for the summer.
