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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DESERT HOT SPRINGS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS FOR THE LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 2, FISCAL YEAR 2017-18

WHEREAS, the City Council has by previous resolutions formed the Desert Hot Springs Landscape and Lighting Maintenance District No. 2 (hereafter referred to as the "District"), and initiated proceedings for Fiscal Year 2017-18, pursuant to the provisions of the Landscape and Lighting Act of 1972, Part 2, Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code (commencing with Section 22500) (hereafter referred to as the "Act"), and Articles XIIIC and XIIID of the Constitution of the State of California (together, the "Constitution") (the Act and the Constitution are referred to collectively as the "Assessment Law") that provides for the levy and collection of assessments by the County of Riverside for the City of Desert Hot Springs to pay the maintenance and services of improvements and facilities related thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has retained Albert A. Webb Associates, for the purpose of assisting with the annual levy and assessments for the District, and to prepare and file a report with the City Clerk in accordance with the Assessment Law; and.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED BYTHE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals

That the recitals set forth above are true and correct.

Section 2. Declaration of Intention

That the City Council hereby declares that its intention to seek an annual levy for the District pursuant to the Assessment Law, over and including the land within the District boundary, and to levy and collect assessments on all such land to pay for the annual costs for the maintenance of the improvements and facilities and services related thereto. The City Council finds that the public's best interest requires such levy and collection.

Section 3. District Boundaries

That the boundaries of the District are described as the boundaries previously defined in the original formation documents of the District, within the boundaries of the City of Desert Hot Springs, County of Riverside, State of California.

Section 4. District Improvements

That the improvements to be maintained and serviced within Landscape and Lighting Maintenance District No. 2, Zones 1 through 15, 17 and 18, shall include, but shall not be limited to, trees, sidewalks, parkways, landscaped slopes and park facilities, and the operation and maintenance of the street lighting system within the District and appurtenant facilities. Services provided include all necessary services, operation, administration and maintenance required to keep the improvements and facilities in a healthy, vigorous and satisfactory working condition.

Section 5. Proposed Assessment Amounts

That for Fiscal Year 2017-18, the proposed assessments for the District are outlined in the Engineer's Annual Levy Report which details any changes or increases in the annual assessment from the previous fiscal year.

Section 6 Notice to Property Owners

The City shall give notice of the time and place of the Public Hearing to all property owners within the District by causing the publishing of this Resolution once in the local newspaper not less than ten (10) days before the date of the Public Hearing, and by posting a copy of this resolution on the official bulletin board customarily used by the City Council for the posting of notices. Any interested person may file a written protest with the City Clerk prior to the conclusion of the Public Hearing, or, having previously filed a protest, may file a written withdrawal of that protest. A written protest shall state all grounds of objection and a protest by a property owner shall contain a description sufficient to identify the property owned by such property owner. At the Public Hearing, all interested persons shall be afforded the opportunity to hear and be heard.

Section 7 Notice of Public Hearing:

Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing on these matters will be held by the City Council on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>July 5</u>, <u>2017 at 6:00 p.m.</u> or as soon thereafter as feasible in the City Council Chambers, located at 11-711 West Drive, Desert Hot Springs, California.

Section 8 Direction to Give Notice

The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of such hearing as provided by law.

Section 9 Severability

That the City Council declares that, should any provision, section, paragraph, sentence or word of this Resolution be rendered or declared invalid by any final court action in a court of competent jurisdiction or by reason of any preemptive legislation, the remaining provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences or words of this Resolution as hereby adopted shall remain in full force and effect.
