RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

The City Council held a Study Session on June 6, 2017. Presentations were received from:

- 1) Coachella Valley Rescue Mission
- 2) Shelter from the Storm
- 3) Path of Life Ministries

At the conclusion of the Study Session, the City Council directed that the matter be placed on the June 20, 2017 Regular Meeting Agenda as an Administrative Calendar Item for further discussion and consideration of the following options:

- 1) That the City support regional homelessness efforts; or
- 2) That the City study homelessness efforts independently; or
- 3) Take no action.

FISCAL IMPACT

The City Council has "earmarked" \$103,000 towards homelessness efforts for FY 2017-18.
