BACKGROUND:

Currently the Desert Hot Springs Municipal Code ("DHSMC") regulates fences in Section 17.40.110. The DHSMC currently does not allow fencing surrounding vacant property. It has come to the City's attention that unprotected vacant property can subject the property owners to illegal dumping. The Ordinance would make it permissive for persons to construct fencing to be used along the perimeter of vacant property in order to secure the property. The City Council held a study session on this item and desired that the fencing along perimeter and of vacant property be post and wire fencing.

PRIOR ACTIONS

On June 13, 2017, the Planning Commission reviewed the draft ordinance and made a recommendation to the Council to approve the ordinance as presented by Staff.
