Code Compliance Synopsis

During the month of June, the Code Compliance/Community Preservation Division completed 287 inspections and responded to 170 service requests. This resulted in the issuance of 42 notice of violations and 20 citations totaling \$6,900.00.

On June 22^{nd,} the newly hired Community Preservation Supervisor, Rusty Hannah started with the city, replacing officer Dave Williams. He brings over 10 years of experience to the department from Riverside County. He has been meeting with Community Development Director Daniel Porras to see what the department can do to improve the City's Community Preservation Department. Christina Archuleta has also been promoted to Community Preservation officer from the administrative staff and an active search is underway to hire a new staff member to fill her old position.

Officers Steve Alvarado and Pam Chaffin continue as part time officers with the department with Officer Alvarado working on abatements and receiverships.

The department is also working diligently on closing and updating current cases and trying to gain compliance.
