Community Preservation Division Synopsis

During the month of September, the Community Preservation Division completed 93 inspections and responded to 39 service requests. This resulted in the issuance of 42 notice of violations and 10 citations totaling \$5,112.00. We also have abated two more underground homeless shelters on private property with the assistance of DHSPD. Public works continues to provide a tractor and operator to abate the tunnels and Desert Valley Disposal removes the trash.

On September 25th the new administrative assistant, Emily Vera started with the Community Preservation Division. She will hopefully free up staff to be more proactive and in the field more often.

The divisions priorities continue to be vacant, substandard houses/buildings, trash/outside storage and vacant lots with trash. The AVA/in-op vehicle program is now up and running and the in-op vehicle policy is now in place.

The division is continuing to patrol Palm Dr., Pierson and other main thoroughfares daily for trash, shopping carts and signs. Forty-two shopping carts were removed from the streets during the month of September.
