Background / Work Experience / Civic Involvement:

My time at USC both as a student and employee has allowed me to become involved in the community and public schools surrounding the campus, which is largely underprivileged and lacks sufficient resources for the arts. Because there is virtually no funding, the arts initiatives and after school programs rely heavily on volunteers to bring music programs to the community. We offer free (or very reduced cost) music lessons to students in surrounding schools, free coaching to their performing ensembles, and most importantly serve as a listening ear/voice to help guide them toward their college goals. While the students do learn and improve on the instruments they study, the bigger goal is keeping them engaged in school and out of trouble.
