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Survey Methodology

From Tuesday, May 23 to Wednesday, June 14 2017, Probolsky Research conducted a multi-mode survey of voters within a disadvantaged unincorporated community (DUC) of Riverside County adjacent to the City of Desert Hot Springs.

We began with a live-interviewer telephone survey, completing 30 surveys (60%) from 1,033 attempts to 312 viable phone numbers. Once we exhausted the telephone sample, we moved to the online survey phase and urged participation via email (2%) and text message (10%). Security measures precluded individuals from completing the survey more than once and allowed only the designated voters to complete the survey. Online respondents could use their computer, tablet or smart phone to participate. We sent emails to all voters with valid email addresses three times and sent text messages to all available mobile phone numbers. Please see below for a complete view of the email and text language sent to all available voter emails and mobile phone numbers. We then moved into door-to-door mode (28%) and sent our field team to collect surveys from DUC voters in-person.

A total of 50 voters were surveyed, representing 13% of the surveyed population. Telephone interviews were conducted with respondents on both landline and mobile (76.7%) phones and were offered in English and Spanish (6%) languages.

Our sample was developed from the voter files originally compiled by the Riverside County Registrar of Voters.

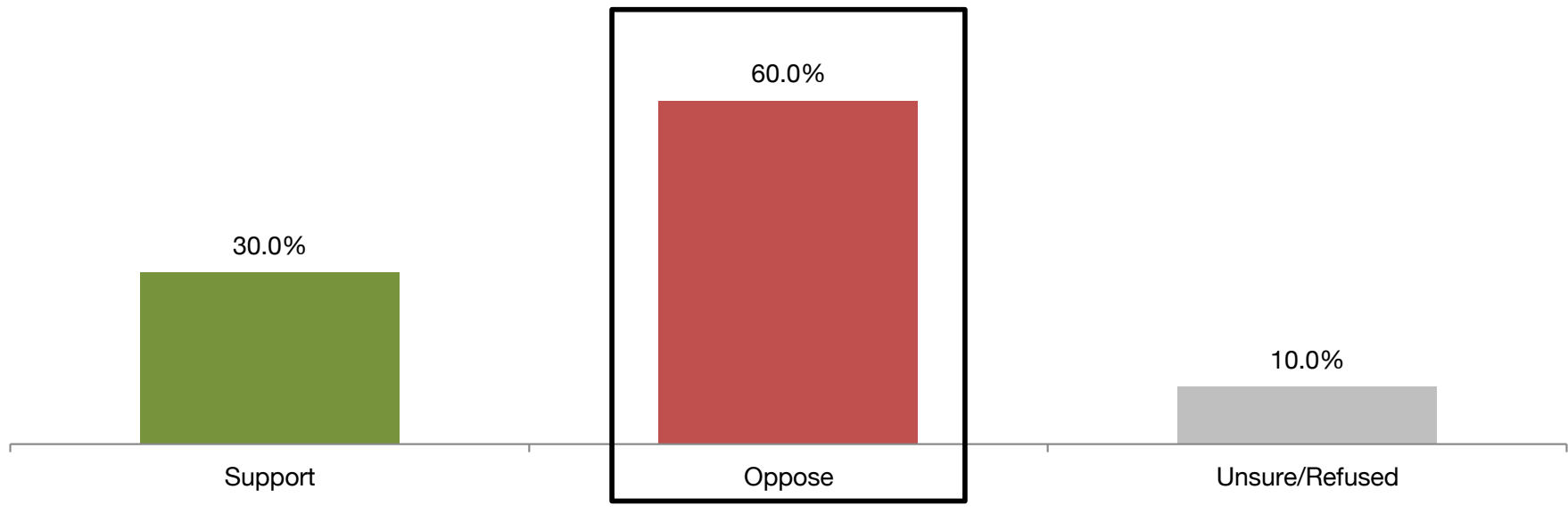
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60% Oppose the Proposed Annexation of Their community into the City of Desert Hot Springs

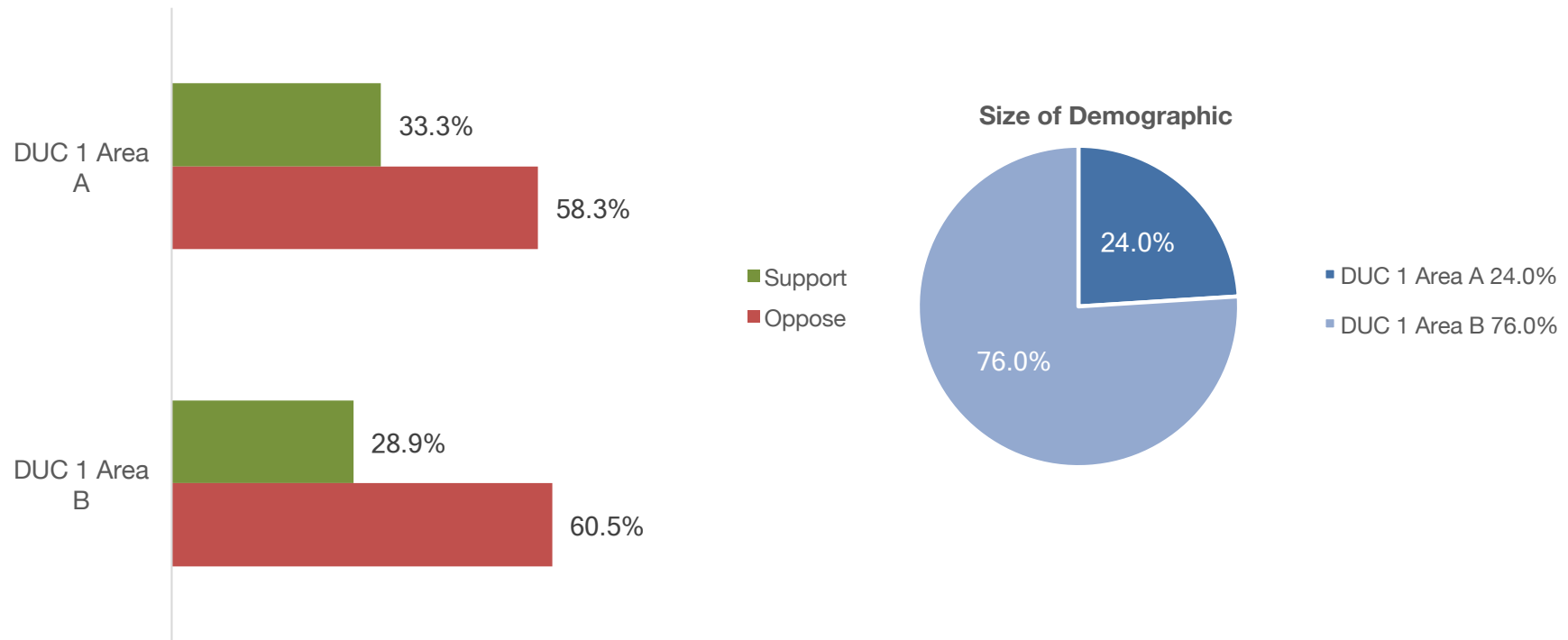

The proposed annexation of their community into DHS

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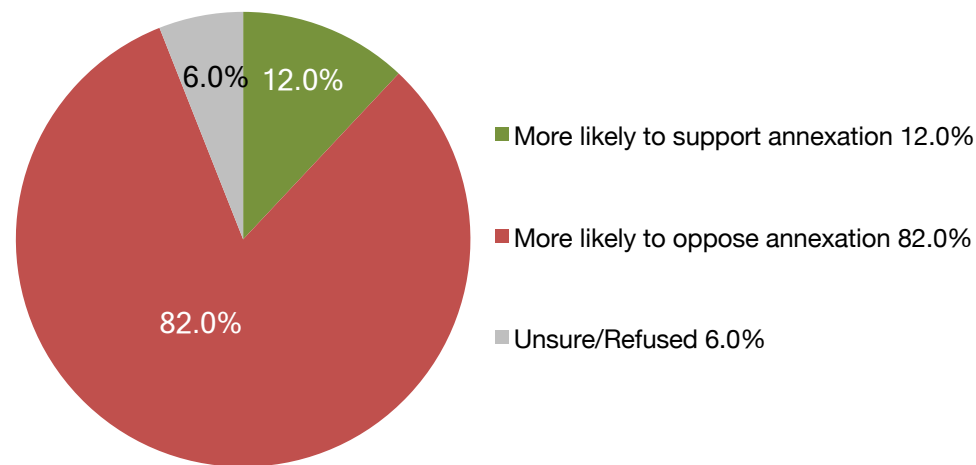

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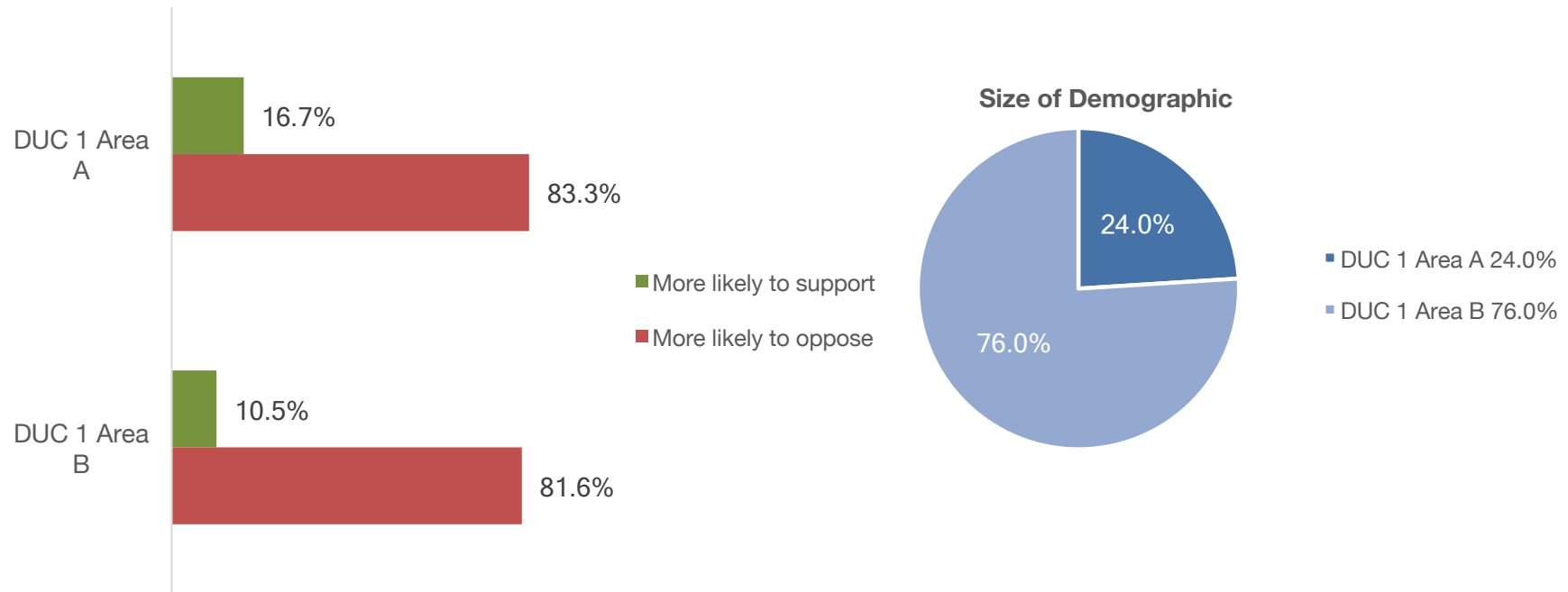

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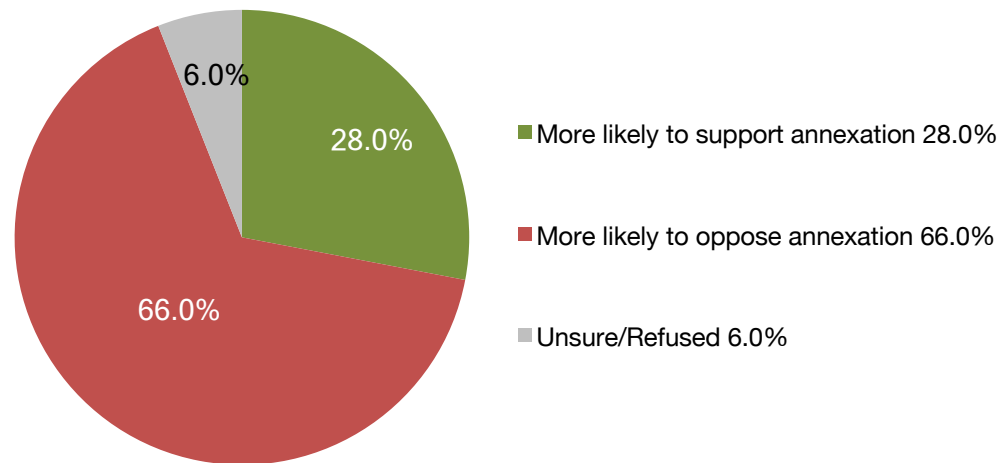

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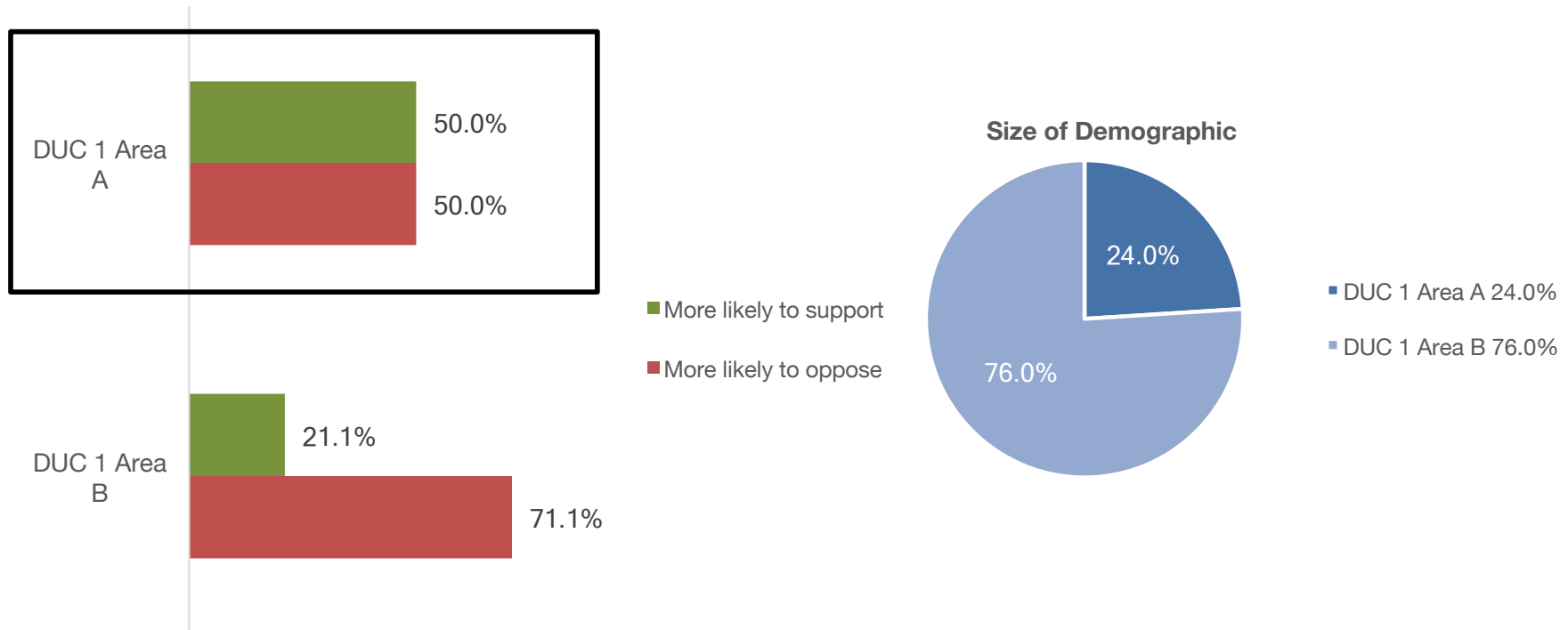

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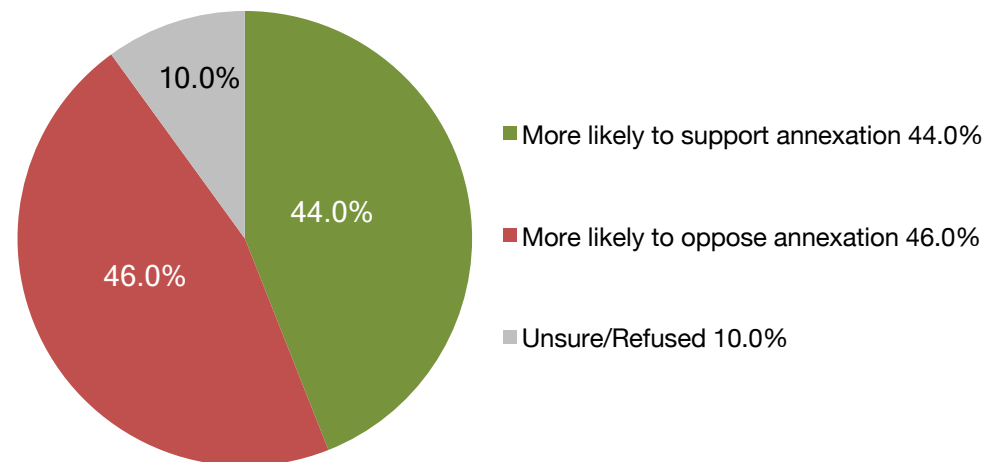

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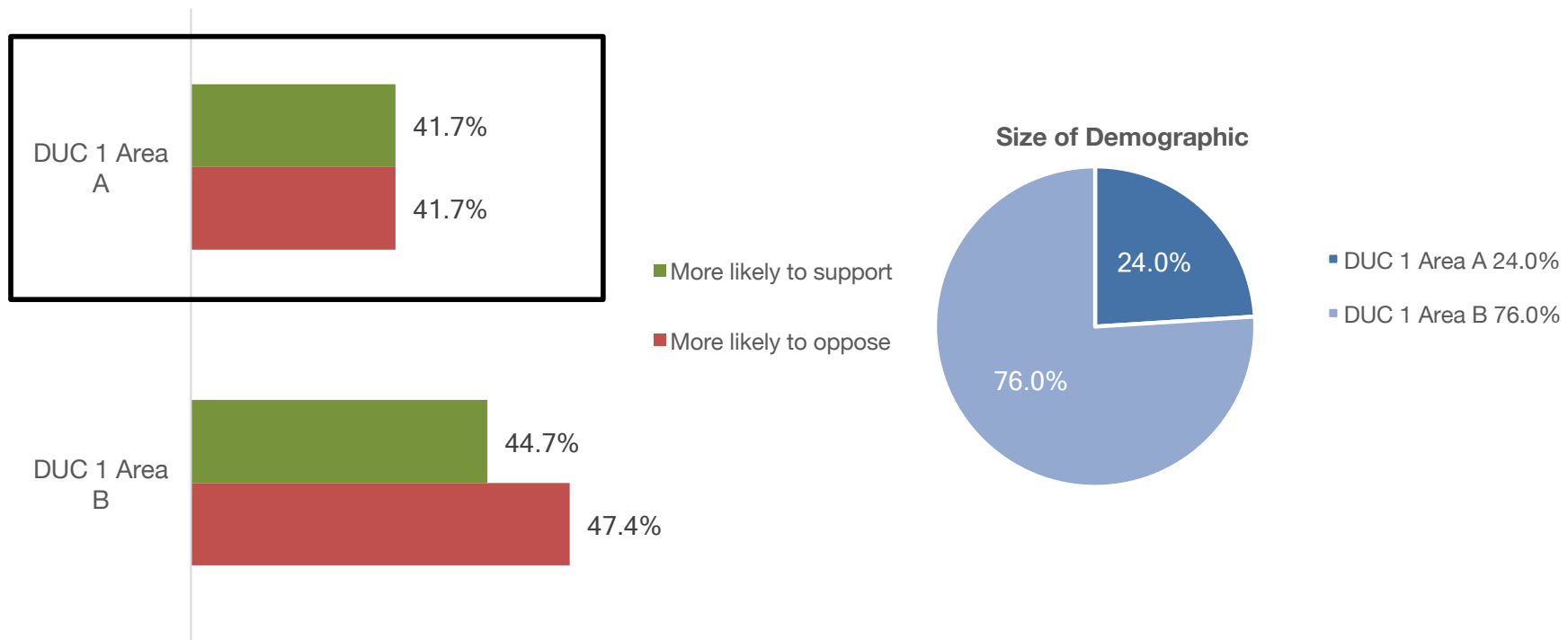

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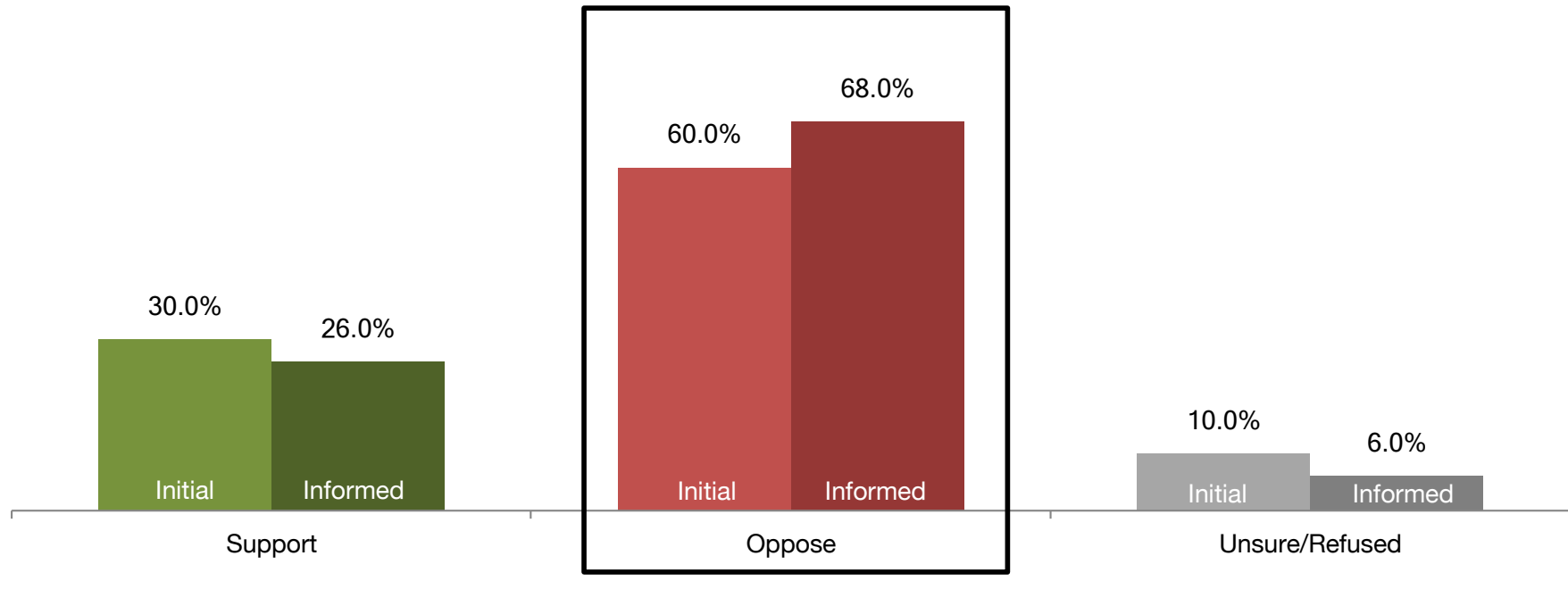
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Opposition towards the Annexation Increases

Question: Knowing what you know now, if you were to decide today on the possible annexation of your community into the City of Desert Hot Springs, would you support or oppose the annexation?



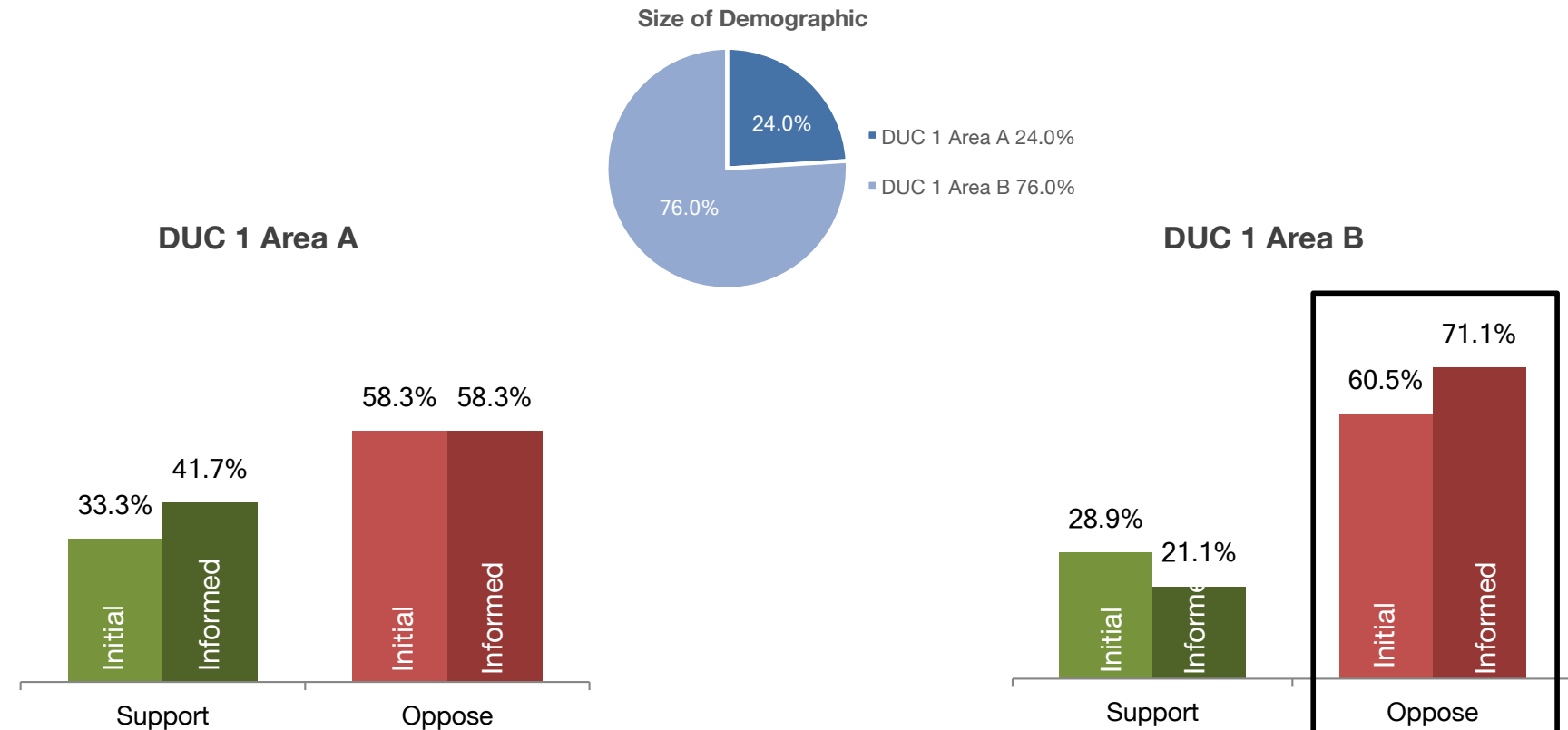
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Opposition towards the Annexation Increases
