1st Lieutenant Joel C. Gentz July 9, 1984 - June 9, 2010 -

Joel Gentz (AAE '07) was killed in action on June 9, 2010 during a medical-evacuation rescue mission when insurgents shot down the Pave Hawk helicopter he was aboard in Helmand Province, Afghanistan. During the short month of his first deployment he accrued 50 hours combat time, flew 84 sorties, conducted 48 assists and saved 39 lives.
