- 1. **Application**: A completed application.
- 2. **<u>Resume</u>**: A resume of the artist's experience.
- 3. <u>**Rendering of Proposed Art**</u>: Copy of drawings, images and/or photos of the conceptual art to be installed on the utility or traffic signal control box.
- 4. **Paints:** Type of paints being used.
- 5. **<u>Cost</u>**: Costs involved in the proposal.
- 6. <u>Site Plan</u>: Showing location of utility or traffic signal control box. A satellite image should be included
- 7. <u>Schedule</u>: Proposed schedule for completion of the project. Shall not be more than 60 days. This will only apply if artist's concept is approved by the City Council.
