APPLICATION SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS**

1. **Application**: A completed application.
2. **Resume**: A resume of the artist's experience.
3. **Rendering of Proposed Art**: Copy of drawings, images and/or photos of the conceptual art to be installed on the utility or traffic signal control box.
4. **Paints**: Type of paints being used.
5. **Cost**: Costs involved in the proposal.
6. **Site Plan**: Showing location of utility or traffic signal control box. A satellite image should be included
7. **Schedule**: Proposed schedule for completion of the project. Shall not be more than 60 days. This will only apply if artist's concept is approved by the City Council.
