The purpose of this Zoning Ordinance is to promote the public health, safety, general welfare, and preserve and enhance the aesthetic quality of the City by providing regulations to ensure an appropriate mix of land uses in an orderly manner.

What specific skills, attitudes, and experience do you think you have that will enhance the work of the Commission?

My specific skills include critical thinking by using logic and reasoning to identify the strengths and weaknesses of alternative solutions, conclusions or approaches to problems. Active listening, giving full attention to what other people are saying, taking time to understand the points being made, asking questions as appropriate, and not interrupting at inappropriate times. Judgment and decision making, considering the relative costs and benefits of potential actions to choose the most appropriate one. Complex problem solving, identifying complex problems and reviewing related information to develop and evaluate options and implement solutions.

Furthermore, I bring experience that includes strategic planning, resource allocation, production methods, and coordination of people and resources. Knowledge of economic and accounting principles and practices.

What specific issues or problems face the commission? Do you have suggestions to address these issues or problems?

I believe the biggest issue or problem the City faces is not having economic prosperity. Most of the problems the City face can be traced back to not having the appropriate funds available. First, as a resident and economic development associate I believe the City has great potential for economic growth. Second, I believe there is in vital need for business revitalization initiatives that will make the City business friendly and will generate business interest from its residents. Appropriate zoning ordinance can preserve and promote a new business center for the City that can be aesthetic while promoting a business sector.
