RECOMMENDATION:

Re-open and extend the application period for the Utility and Traffic Control Boxes and Mural Programs through February 28, 2019.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

Call for Artists for the Utility and Traffic Control Box and Mural programs were opened during the following periods:

- Utility and Traffic Control Box Program - August 17 through September 17, 2018
- Mural Program - September 17 through October 17, 2018

Artists and the public have indicated that one month is not enough time to prepare the applications.

The Commission is being asked to re-open the application period for both programs and extend it over a three month time period through February 28, 2019. Once that time period is complete, the Commission can evaluate and decide to extend it further.

FISCAL IMPACT:

None at present. The only funds that would be used would be from the Art in Public Places budget should applications be received.
