RECOMMENDATION:

Re-open and extend the application period for the Utility and Traffic Control Boxes and Mural Programs though February 28, 2019.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

Call for Artists for the Utility and Traffic Control Box and Mural programs were opened during the following periods:

- Utility and Traffic Control Box Program August 17 through September 17, 2018
- Mural Program September 17 through October 17, 2018

Artists and the public have indicated that one month is not enough time to prepare the applications.

The Commission is being asked to re-open the application period for both programs and extend it over a three month time period through February 28, 2019. Once that time period is complete, the Commission can evaluate and decide to extend it further.

FISCAL IMPACT:
