








About the Artist

Throughout Julian Hoeber's practice, he has worked on various projects to produce disorienting phenomenological experiences. Much of what drives his practice is a search for ways to exceed the limits set by opposing ideas such as organic and inorganic, structured and chaotic, conceptual and expressive. Most of his work is an attempt to reconcile the sides of these oppositions. For the last several years, he has been using design and architecture as a way to explore these themes. One way he's done this is by combining the vocabulary of vernacular structures, like funhouses, with that of Modernism and Minimalism to make a rational structure produce irrational responses. He strives to show how the discursive, exploratory process of design, as well as its final product, alter and reflect the processes of the mind and body.
