The City of Desert Hot Springs is accepting applications to be considered for appointment to serve on the <u>Coachella Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District</u> (CVMVCD).

## ABOUT THE CVMVCD:

The CVMVCD is a special district whose mission is to reduce the risk of disease transmission, by mosquitos and other vectors, for residents and visitors of the Coachella Valley.

The Board of Trustees are officials appointed by their respective city councils to govern the CVMVCD knowledgeably and effectively. Trustees are highly dedicated to this community service. Trustees are appointed for a fixed term of either two (2) years or four (4) years.

The District operates under California Health and Safety Code 2000-2093. Its boundaries encompass 2400 square miles which include the cities of Cathedral City, Coachella, Desert Hot Springs, Indian Wells, Indio, La Quinta, Palm Desert, Palm Springs, Rancho Mirage, and Riverside County.
