### RESOLUTION NO. 2019-\_\_\_\_

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DESERT HOT SPRINGS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, INITIATING PROCEEDINGS FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS FOR THE DRAINAGE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-20

WHEREAS, the City Council has by previous resolutions formed and levied annual assessments for Drainage Assessment District No. 1 (hereafter sometimes referred to as the "District"), pursuant to the terms and provisions of the Benefit Assessment Act of 1982, Chapter 6.4, Division 2, Title 5 of the California Government Code (commencing with Section 54703) (the "1982 Act"), Article XIIID of the Constitution of the State of California ("Article XIIID") and the Proposition 218 Omnibus Implementation Act (Government Code Section 53750 and following) (the "Implementation Act") (the 1982 Act, Article XIIID and the Implementation Act are referred to collectively as the "Assessment Law"), in what is known and designated as the Drainage Assessment District No. 1 (the "District"); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has retained Webb Municipal Finance, LLC, for the purpose of assisting with the Annual Levy of the District, and to prepare and file a report with the City Clerk in accordance with the Assessment Law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS:

### Section 1. Recitals

That the Recitals set forth above are true and correct.

### Section 2. Annual Levy Report

That the City Council hereby orders Webb Municipal Finance, LLC, to prepare and file with the City Clerk the Engineer's Annual Levy Report concerning the levy and collection of assessments for the District for the Fiscal Year commencing July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020 in accordance with the Assessment Law.

### Section 3. District Improvements

That the improvements provided within Drainage Assessment District No. 1, Zones 1 through 17 may include, but are not limited to: flood control facilities, fences, masonry walls, and associated appurtenant facilities. Services provided include all necessary services, operations, administration and maintenance, including graffiti removal, required to keep the above mentioned improvements and facilities in a healthy, vigorous and satisfactory working condition.

### Section 4. Severability

That the City Council declares that, should any provision, section, paragraph, sentence or word of this Resolution be rendered or declared invalid by any final court action in a court of competent jurisdiction or by reason of any preemptive legislation, the remaining provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences or words of the Resolution as hereby adopted shall remain in full force and effect.

#### Section 5. Effective Date

That this Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.

## Section 6. Certification

That the City Clerk shall certify as to the adoption of this Resolution and shall cause the same to be processed in the manner required by law.

# Section 7. Repeal of Conflicting Provisions

That all the provisions heretofore adopted by the City Council that are in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.
