RECOMMENDATION

Consider whether to direct Staff to place the item on a future agenda for action.

BACKGROUND:

The California Alliance for Renewable Energy Solutions, a non-profit, non-partisan organization, is seeking local support the proposed pumped storage project located in Eagle Mountain, California.

The project will augment the transmission grid connecting the large power markets of Southern and Mid-California, helping meet the requirements of the State for significant new and replacement power sources immediately and over the next several decades. The project will also assist the State with its mandated goal of 50% of energy to come from renewable sources by 2030.

DISCUSSION:

This Item was submitted by Mayor Matas on April 23, 2019 pursuant to Resolution No. 2019-004 (Exhibit 1). This Resolution sets forth the Policy for placing items on an agenda by the Mayor or 2 Council Members.

In accordance with the Policy, the City Council, during the discussion, shall consider whether to direct Staff to place an item on a subsequent agenda for “action” upon a majority vote of the City Council.
