RECOMMENDATION

Ratify Council Member Griffith's appointment to the Planning Commission to fill one (1) vacancy consisting of an unexpired term ending January 2020.

DISCUSSION

On June 25, 2019, Robert Griffith was appointed to the City Council resulting in one (1) vacancy on the Planning Commission:

Appointment Process:

Pursuant to Desert Hot Springs Municipal Code ("DHSMC") Section 2.24.030, if vacancies in any commission occur other than by expiration of term, such vacancy shall be filled by appointment of the Council Member who appointed the Commissioner being replaced, with ratification by a majority of the City Council. Council Member Griffith was appointed to fill the seat vacated by Anayeli Zavala. Accordingly, Council Member Griffith is designated by the Municipal Code to appoint his replacement.

Additionally, pursuant to DHSMC Section 2.24.020, the term of the replacement appointment for an interim vacancy is for the "unexpired" term of the member replaced. Therefore, the term of the replacement appointment would end January 2020.

Pursuant to The Maddy Act (set forth in Government Code Section 54970 *et. seq.*), a special vacancy notice (Exhibit 1) was posted by the City Clerk on August 7, 2019.
