Project Description – Two Bunch Palms

This project would replace and expand the treatment facilities at the Two Bunch Palms Resort and Spa through construction of eighteen freestanding Treatment Rooms made of sandblasted precast concrete panels with wood windows, accents, and millwork. Fifteen of these structures will be for massage treatments (285–378 sf, each), one will be a Steam Room (378 sf), another a specialty 'Salt Cave' (868 sf) and a third would be a Mud Bath Room (378 sf). One painted or stucco back-of-house service building (755 sf) would also be constructed.

These new buildings will be built to the southeast of the existing spa and pool areas and will extend the landscape palette of native plantings and paving materials that has been established in other recent renovations at the resort. Alongside these treatment rooms will be a series of freestanding outdoor mineral water tubs and one exterior communal mud bath. The new treatment rooms will replace and improve upon several existing older, metal treatment rooms, which are to be demolished as part of the work. Existing flora, including two palm tree bunches, will be protected and preserved.
