## BACKGROUND

The City of Desert Hot Springs Municipal Code ("DHSMC") regulates fences in Section 17.40.110. The DHSMC currently provides that the Director of Development Services must make findings in order for an applicant to erect a fence. Such findings are cumbersome and impede the development of fences, especially where fences are necessary.

The proposed Ordinance seeks to: 1) not require such findings as they are cumbersome to development and are not needed; 2) allow for more color options for block walls, so long as the colors match or compliment the adjacent structures; and 3) allows for chain link fencing for properties over 5 acres where the Code Compliance manager deems that fencing is needed to inhibit nuisances.
